A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

I saw it almost every morning on the breakfast table growing up. For along with her Bible, my mom's copy of *The Upper Room* daily devotional was usually present. Unfortunately, however, it wasn't until after going out on my own that I appreciated not just the spiritual strength of a regular devotional, but also found that knowing we were reading the same words each morning provided a bridge back to my mother and to her faith, as well.

But then I was hardly the first one to discover the power of that little bi-monthly booklet. For when first produced in 1935, the first 100,000 copies of *The Upper Room* quickly sold out, and by 1938, it was also being published in Korean, Spanish, and Hindustani. A Braille edition began in 1940, and by 1944, the circulation had passed the two million mark. And in late 2009, it's said that the number of copies of the magazine officially passed one billion!

All of which speaks to the ongoing need in each of our lives for a spiritual connection with God, whether through regularly reading *The Upper Room* or *Our Daily Bread*, or through programs like the "Walk to Emmaus" which *The Upper Room* folks have created. And in that regard, we are especially pleased to welcome the current publisher of *The Upper Room*, who also serves as an Associate General Secretary of Discipleship Ministries within our denomination, to Christ Church this morning.

Formerly with the Houston Grand Opera before entering ministry, the Reverend Kimberly Orr is a clergy member of the Texas Annual Conference, last serving on the staff of Windsor Village UMC prior to her move to Nashville. A teacher, pastor, scholar, and writer, she holds degrees from Sam Houston, Rice University Shepherd School of Music, and Asbury Theological Seminary, and is currently in a doctoral program at The University of South Africa in Pretoria. In addition to preaching at our 10:30 traditional service, Reverend Orr will lead a Spiritual Gifts Workshop today following the morning services. I have to think my mom would have loved hearing her, and I have a feeling that you will too.




