



## Family Ministries Summer Intern

The Family Ministries Summer Intern position (FMSI) is designed to equip ministry leaders who feel a calling to full-time vocational ministry, as well as those excited to serve in local church ministry with children and youth. Those in the internship will gain insight to what is involved with full-time church ministry work as a program staff member with children and youth and also with the other ministries of Christ Church Sugar Land. The FMSI will be accountable to the Director of Children's Ministries, Director of Youth Ministries and to the designated pastor(s), and shall also work closely with other members of the church staff as appropriate.

Qualifications for the position shall normally include the completion of at least one year of college or post high school work experience. Applicants should have experience with spiritual formation, leadership, speaking to groups, administration and working on a team. The FMSI should also show evidence of personal maturity, an understanding of Christian discipleship, people-skills for working with volunteers and a heart of service to others. The FMSI should be a positive role-model for the children and youth in behavior and spiritual discipline.

The FMSI is a full-time salaried (exempt) position at Christ Church Sugar Land normally serving ten to twelve weeks from mid-May through mid-August. Housing is not included in this position: the church may, however, assist a candidate if needed in finding a host family for the internship period. The typical work week is Sunday through Thursday with some Fridays and Saturdays included as needed. The \$3,000 stipend is for a 12-week internship or can be pro-rated for a pre-approved lesser term. Insurance and other benefits are not included with this short-term position.

Family Ministries Summer Intern will be expected to:

1. Work full-time in the Children and Youth ministries programs, including regular programming and special events during the day and/or in the evenings.
2. Attend and participate in retreats, work and mission camps, and other extended programs as requested which may involve time away from the church campus or home for a period of several days.
3. Develop relationships with our children and youth.
4. Be present for Sunday School to assist in children's and youth classes.
5. Teach lessons or offer devotional talks in a variety of age-level activities.
6. Be present for the weeks of) June 20-24 (Vacation Bible School Prep or Lakeview Camp), June 27-July 1 (VBS) and July 17-22 (High School UM ARMY).
7. Be punctual and reliable in their daily work
8. Help prepare resources for programs and offer other program and administrative support.
